GRAND RIVERVIEW BALLROOM

Equipped with a lift stage for dramatic introductions, the 40,000 square-foot ballroom is dividable with a retractable wall and complemented by glass-enclosed, pre-function space and an open-air terrace overlooking the Detroit River and the skyline of Windsor, Ontario. The Grand Riverview Ballroom has a 3,500 theater seating capacity, 2,250 banquet seating, or will hold 4,500 for a reception. Used for banquets, weddings, award ceremonies, dinners, political conventions, media presentations and a myriad of other functions, the new Cobo Center Grand Riverview Ballroom undoubtedly enhances the events it holds.

COBO CUISINE

Our professional chefs serve up award winning recipes with locally sourced ingredients daily from the new state-of-the-art 8,000 square foot kitchen. Equipped with a private tasting room, customers can work with the Cobo culinary team to develop custom menus for their events.

The food offerings include Cork & Grind that serves coffee, wine and small plates, Go natural with fresh offerings prepared daily and the Made in Detroit Food Court, including burgers, pizza and deli in the City View Lounge with full views of the downtown scene, just steps away. COBO SQUARE

The new 24,000 square-foot outdoor space that can be used for programming such as exhibits, exercise and yoga, biergartens and other elements designed to connect Cobo Center to the community and the downtown Detroit culture. When combined with the outdoor terrace, that wraps around the building and offers great views overlooking the Detroit Riverfront, the total outdoor flex space is 45,000 square feet.

Cobo Center is at the heart of a revitalized downtown core, bursting with arts, culture and entertainment; we are within walking distance of stores, over 100 new restaurants, shops and businesses, new hotels and attractions such as:

- + The District Detroit and new home of the Detroit Red Wings and Detroit Pistons, Little Caesars Arena and Events Center, will transform 50 city blocks into a thriving new entertainment district. The District will include the arena, housing, retail, bars and restaurants.
- + Boutiques and stores like Bon Bon Bon, Filson, John Varvatos, the Nike Store, Pure Detroit, Shinola, Third Man Records and Warby Parker.
- + New boutique hotels like Element Metropolitan (2018), The Foundation, the Shinola Hotel (2018) and West Elm (2018). Public spaces like Campus Martius and the world-class Detroit International Riverfront.
- + The new QLine streetcar gives visitors and residents the ability to hop on and travel down Detroit's historic Woodward Avenue for 3 miles; delivering attendees to restaurants, museums, attractions, and gathering places.
