Faxed or emailed bids shall not be accepted for any reason. A bidder will be permitted to withdraw his bid, unopened, after it has been submitted if so requested <u>prior</u> to the time specified above for opening of proposals.

Proposals will be publicly opened on **September 27**, **starting at 2:00 p.m.**, local time, by the DRCFA, at One Washington Blvd, Detroit, MI 48226. Interested parties may join in person upon arrival to the Administrative Offices on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor. RFP evaluation and award subsequently will be made by the Board of Directors at the DRCFA. The successful bidder(s) shall be required to enter into a contract with the DRCFA.

DRCFA is exempt from sales or use tax for all direct purchases of tangible personal property, but bidders may be responsible for state sales or use taxes for purchased materials that are used and affixed by bidder to real property owned by DRCFA. The Authority will provide a sales tax exemption form upon request.
